

## How to manage your ECM Titanium backups

### General information

The installation of ECM Titanium provides a backup management tool which allows you to make a backup copy of the ECM Titanium flash drive data on your computer and restore them later.

The data included in the backup are:

- Your projects, containing, in compressed format:
  - original files
  - modified files
- ECM Titanium database, containing:
  - user's data
  - the list of original and modified file names related to the projects
  - the list of downloaded driver names

You must have a backup of your ECM Titanium data:

1. When data are corrupted, for example due to viruses or malware
2. When the SD memory card is replaced
3. When the SD memory card or flash drive is damaged

**Therefore, it is highly recommended to periodically back up your data, so that you always have the latest ones available.** To this end, you can set in the ECM Titanium software how often to display a reminder.


### Warnings

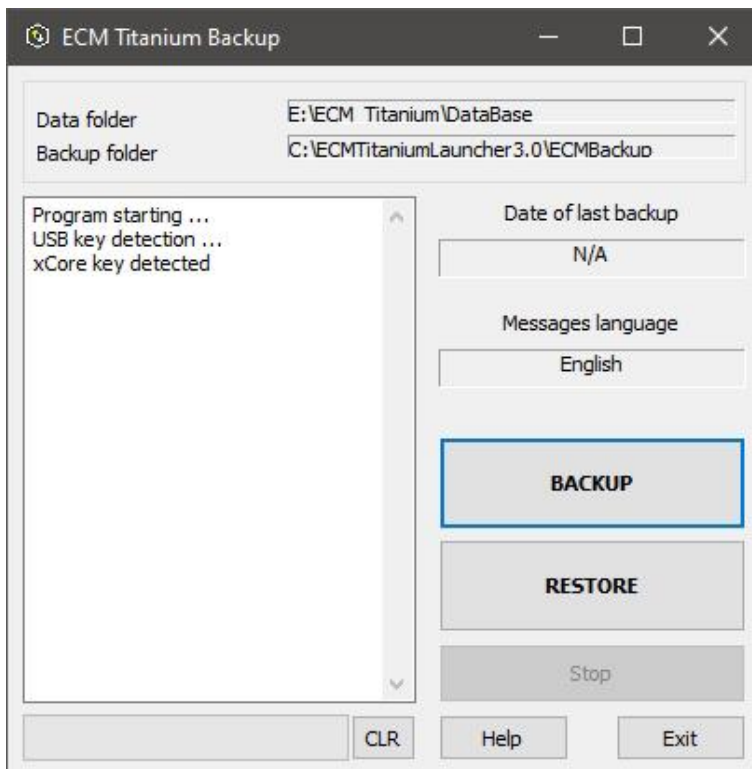
**You cannot write a backup of a key to another one.**

If you need to restore a backup, the data on the ECM Titanium key will be overwritten.

You will need to manage manually any personal data saved on the SD memory card, whenever possible.

### How to make a backup


1. Close *ECM Titanium* software;
2. Run the *ECM Titanium Backup* software by clicking the icon  on your desktop;
3. Click *Backup* and wait for the operation to complete;
4. Close the *ECM Titanium Backup* software.

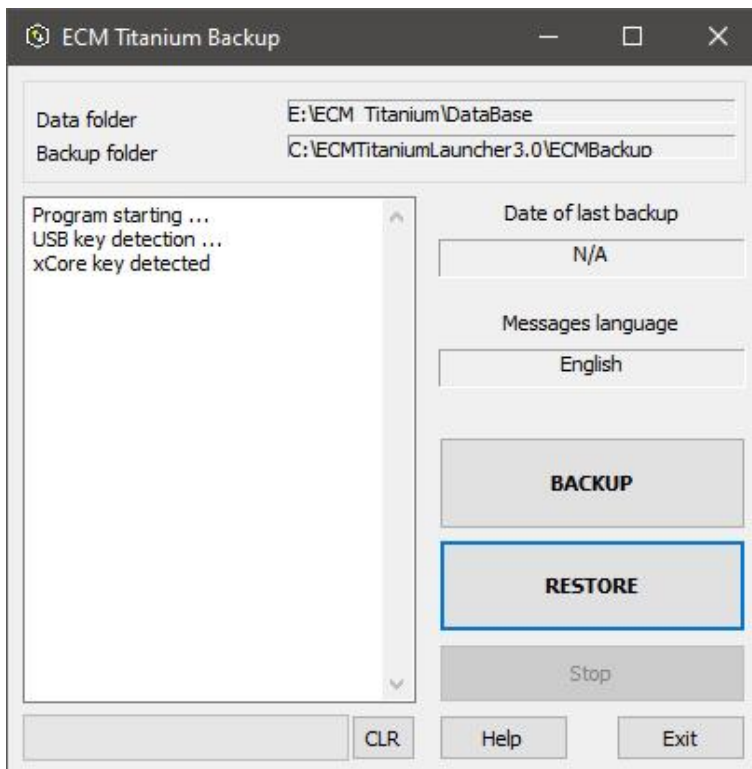


Time needed to backup the data varies depending on the amount of data to be saved.

## How to restore a backup


To restore the ECM Titanium data, you must already have the backup.

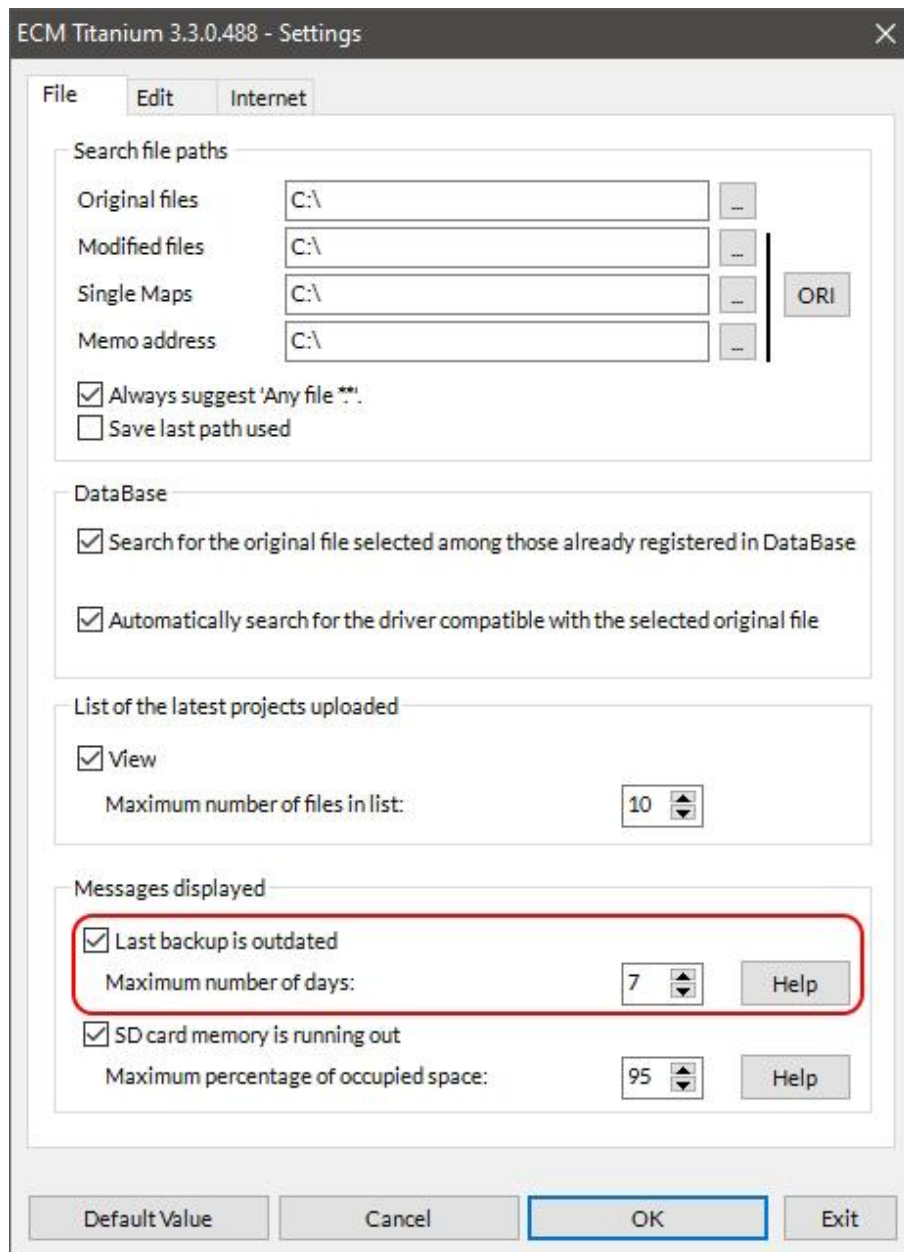
1. Format or replace the SD memory card as needed;
2. Plug the ECM flash drive into your computer;
3. Install the ECM Titanium software (you can download the ECM Titanium 3.0 software from the Dashboard Download Area);
4. If you opened the software at the end of the installation, close it without working on it, so as not to risk overwriting new projects not included in the backup;
5. Run the *ECM Titanium Backup* software by clicking the icon  on your desktop;
6. Click *Restore* and wait for the operation to complete;
7. Close the *ECM Titanium Backup* software.



Time needed to restore the data varies depending on the amount of data.

## How to set the reminder frequency

1. Run the *ECM Titanium* software;
2. Click the icon  in the toolbar;
3. In the *Messages displayed* panel, act on the arrows next to the "Last backup is outdated" box to increase or decrease the frequency at which displaying the reminder:



4. Click *OK* to save the setting.
